Home Repair/Chore Services
Home Repair and Chore Services
are available through Senior
Services of Van Buren County with
funding received from the Covert
Township Senior Millage. Both
programs are available to residents age 60 and over who live in
Covert Township.

Home Repairs: Qualifying residents can receive one home repair for no more than \$1,000 every other funding year (July thru June). The home repairs are considered permanent improvements to a home to prevent or remedy a sub-standard condition or safety hazard.

Chore Services: Qualifying residents can receive up to \$500 every year (July thru June) and can have many chores during the year but the total amount for one year on all chores is \$500. Chore services are household maintenance repairs to increase the safety of the senior.

Care Watch, Home Repair, and Chore Service are funded through Covert Township Senior Millage. The Care Watch program helps evaluate the needs of a senior resident, assists in making connections, and helping with care providers.

Minimum 24 hour notice is necessary for your ride, 269 427 7921. If you need a wheelchair van, call Senior Services of Van Buren County at 637 3607.
