In August 2022, Covert Township voters approved a 1 mill proposal to fund services for Covert residents age 60 and over. This millage will be used to continue chore and home repair services from the Township, as well as provide residents access to all that Senior Services of Van Buren County has to offer. This includes FREE access to South Haven's new facility offering a place to gather, learn, eat, play, and exercise. Covert Township will also have a dedicated Care Coordinator to assist individuals who would benefit from in-home assistance or community services and resources. Property Taxes

Winter Tax bills are due February 28, 2023. On March 1, 2023 they will be turned over to the Van Buren County Treasurer in Paw Paw where additional penalties and interest will be added. After March 1, 2023 you will not be able to pay at the Township Hall.



Poverty Exemption: This exemption provides a property tax exemption for the principal residence

of persons, who by reason of poverty, are unable to contribute toward the public charges.

Disabled Veterans Exemption: This property tax exemption applies to a disabled veteran who was discharged from the armed forces of the United States under honorable conditions or his or her unremarried surviving spouse. This is filed annually with the supervisor or assessing offices any time after December 31 and before, or until the conclusion of, the December Board of Review.

Two ways to Appeal

- In-Person: By Appointment ONLY held at the Township Hall. Call Laura at 269-764-5138 to set up an appointment. Appeals heard on: Monday March 13, 2023 from 2:00-5:00 p.m. & 6:00-9:00 p.m. Saturday, March 18, 2023 from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. & 1:00-4:00 p.m.
- **2. By Letter:** The 2023 March Board of Review must receive your appeal letter and all accompanying documents by **Thursday, March 16, 2023** at 4:00 p.m. Deadline also appears on your assessment notice.

Poverty Exemption: In addition to your proof of income and other financial documents required, you will need to complete the application for a Poverty Exemption. All documents must accompany a completed and signed application at the time of your Board of Review hearing. Necessary forms can be found on our website at <u>www.coverttwp.com</u>

Disabled Veterans Exemption: In addition to your annual Veteran's Administration statement showing that you are a disabled veteran, you will need to complete the Disabled Veterans Exemption Affidavit. Necessary forms can be found on our website at www.coverttwp.com

Taxpayers must protest first to the March Board of Review in order to protect your rights To appeal further to the Michigan Tax Tribunal. Appeals of property classification must also be appealed first at the March Board of Review before you can appeal further to the State Tax Commission.

To appeal a decision of the March Board of Review, you must Petition to the Michigan Tax Tribunal. The appropriate appeal form can be found on the Tribunal's website at: www.michigan.gov/taxtribunal.
